## 3. Rules and Regulations

The Walther Trophy Target Sprint 2020 will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations for ISSF Target Sprint Competition "Edition 2017 – Version 11/2018". Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

Juries will be designated by the Organizing Committee to supervise the Competition. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable licenses will conduct the competitions.

#### **Rifle / Pistol Equipment**

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory. However, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing according to ISSF Target Sprint Rules and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

## Air or CO<sub>2</sub> Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

## 4. Participation

The Walther Trophy Target Sprint 2020 is open for all regional team, clubs and individuals. ISSF Member Federations have to participate in the World Tour Target Sprint Italian Open 2020.

#### **Individual Event**

There is no maximum enter number of athletes per individual event.

Each athlete competes in two competitions, the athlete with the lowest total time from the sum of both competitions wins.

#### **Single Mixed Team Event**

There is no maximum enter number of teams per team event. A team is consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman.

Each team competes in two competitions, the team with the lowest total time from the sum of both competitions wins.

#### **Juniors**

Juniors are athletes who will be under the age of 21 on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020.

#### Master

Masters are athletes who will be over the age of 50.

#### **Entries**

Regional team, clubs and individuals entering the competition must submit the Entries not later than **24.04.2020**. Please complete the Entry Form (Annex 1 and/or 2) and return it by email to the OC.

All Team Leaders must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Entries including entries for the team events. The confirmation must be completed on the day before the open training/ first competition day.

## 7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

#### Visa

All Regional teams, clubs and individuals that need official invitations from the *Organizing Committee* are requested to order these before **24.04.2020**. Please provide us the Visa Support Form (Annex 5) **typed on PC** and as a **word document**!

Unless the Organizing Committee receives a special request, the invitation will be send by e-mail. If an express service is requested, the cost of this service will be charged to the team, club and individuals and must be paid to the Organizing Committee upon arrival.

#### Police permit - Gun License

By the Italian law to import a gun to Italy it is necessary to be in possession of an approved gun importation form (Annex 4), certified by the Italian authorities. This is valid also for air guns. Please make sure that you carry along a copy of your certified gun form.

Additionally, it is recommended to all delegations to carry a list of all weapons with themselves, to be presented to customs or border police upon request together with the invitation.

Please fill in the gun importation form (Annex 4) and send it back to the Organizing Committee before 24 April 2020.

Attention: Take care that on each form you can sign a maximum of three weapons. The form account holder must be over the age of 18.

Owners of a **European Firearms Passport (EFP)** may import their weapons **without** an auxiliary permission to Italy, but it is required that all the guns (even air guns) are listed in the EFP. Durin your stay in Ora/Italy all arms and ammunition must be stored in the armory on the Ora Shooting Range.

## 10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Center / Venue

## **Technical Meeting**

The Technical Meeting will take place on 28 May 2020 at the Venue.

Each participating regional team and clubs should have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the Competition.

The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Entry Deadline.

#### Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

It is not allowed to take any arms and ammunition out of the Venue and especially not to the hotel. This law also must be followed strictly by nations that are in the **possession of an European Firearms Passport!!** The armory will be checked every evening to be sure all guns are returned. The armory will be open from **27 May 2020 (afternoon)** to **31 May 2020 (morning) ONLY!** 

## For arrival please note:

Upon your arrival in Italy (Ora), all guns and ammunition must be transported to the Shooting Centre in Ora **in the most direct way**. All federations entering Italy with the Temporary Importation Form must store their arms and ammunition on the Shooting Range Ora **ONLY**.

#### For departure:

All arms and ammunition must be removed from the armory to the airport in the most direct way. Even owners of an European Firearms Passport must pick up their arms and ammunition at the armory at time of departure, not earlier. Please keep in mind, that in Italy even owners of a European Firearms Passport are not allowed to leave their arms and ammunition unattended.

## 11. Ceremonies

#### **Victory Ceremony**

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the venue after the end of each Final (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official uniform or tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

#### Flags and Anthems

The Organizing Committee does not need any flags or anthems from the delegations.



## 12. Weather Information

You may expect minimum temperatures of 18°C in the days and not less than 8°C in the nights. Nevertheless, temperatures in *Ora* are very unpredictable at this moment, so it could be very hot or rainy and cold.
